- Paper towels, cloth towels, or any type of rag
- Feminine hygiene products
- Facial Tissues

Putting these items down toilets may plug sewers and cause raw sewage to back up into YOUR HOME



This is a \$2,000 sewer pump like those in our system that was installed 2 years ago. Pumps should last around 15 years. This pump has been destroyed from wipes/towels being flushed. It will cost \$2,000 plus labor to replace.
